

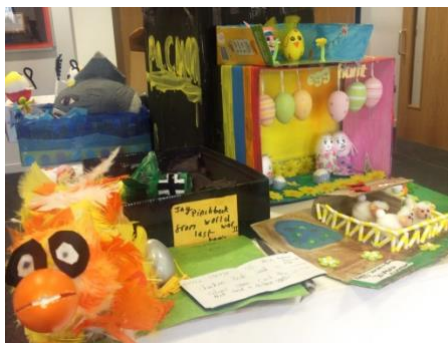
## Easter Bonnet Parade

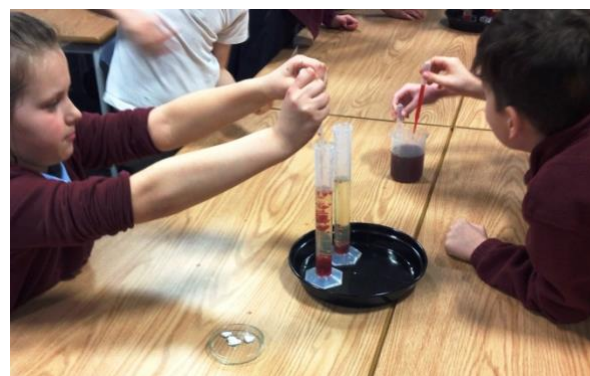
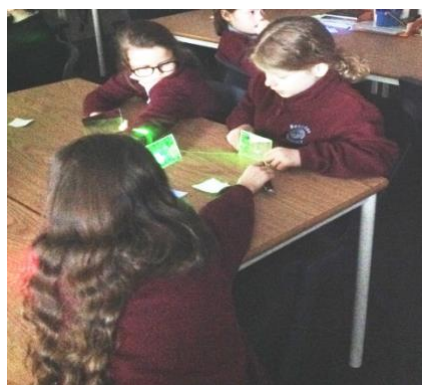
