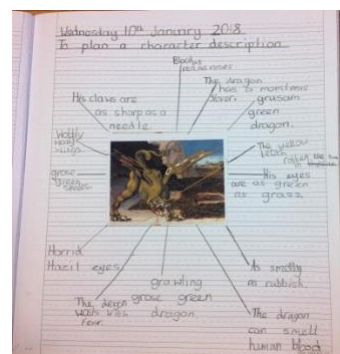


Take One Picture: George and the Dragon.
