**Year 6: Could you be the next famous inventor?**

English	<p>In literacy lessons, we will be looking at the following genres:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Biographies – focusing on the Author and Characters from Charlie and the Chocolate Factory.</li> <li>• Autobiographies</li> <li>• Poetry – including imaginary poetry linked to a scene from Charlie and The Chocolate factory e.g. the boat ride .</li> <li>• Fantasy Stories – leading to writing a story in our own factor</li> <li>• Persuasive arguments – Why you should win the golden ticket?</li> </ul>
Maths	<p>In maths we will be focusing on shape, space and measures. The children will be able to use, read, write and convert between standard units; converting measurements of length, mass, volume and time from a smaller unit of measure to a larger unit, and vice versa. The children will also begin to prepare for their SATs tests.</p>
Science	<p>In science we will be looking at the following people and how they have influenced the world: Charles Darwin, Thomas Edison, Neil Armstrong and Isaac Newton. They will also be researching inventors and a scientist they are interested in.</p>
Computing	<p>Children will be inventing their own computer games: designing, writing and debugging programs that accomplish specific goals, including controlling or simulating physical systems; solving problems by decomposing them into smaller parts and correcting errors in algorithms and programs.</p>
PE	<p>The children will be working with a gymnastics coach and rehearsing and performing dance routines.</p>
Art/D&T	<p>Children will be researching chocolate products, looking at the design and advertising of regular brands of chocolate. They will then design, make and advertise their own chocolate product to sell at the end of the term.</p>
