Could you survive in the African Savanna?

English	The children will begin focusing on writing a newspaper report. This will link to our Africa theme. Within the writing sessions, we will look at possessive apostrophes and determiners. The children will then write a story from another culture. We will look at including description, speech, subordinate clauses and different sentence types. This term the children will also be looking at writing poetry and the different types of poetry.
Numeracy	First this term, the children will look at measurement. The focus will be on converting units of measure, telling time and money word problems. The children will then look at geometry and learn about angles, shapes and symmetry. Year 4 will then be looking at statistics.
PSHE	This term the children will be focusing on 'Relationships /changing me'. The children will look at family trees and how their lives will change/have changed as they grow older.
Geography	In geography, the children will develop their locational knowledge and their human and physical geography skills. They will locate countries on maps and focus on the similarities and differences between different parts of the world.
Computing	In ICT lessons the children will be learning how to research using age appropriate search engines. They will be taught how to scan and read for information.
Art	The children will be looking at painting with watercolours to create a background. We look at different techniques for painting and how we can create a mood within our artwork.
PE	We are delighted to offer the children the experience of working with a PE coach in their PE lessons this term. The year 4 children will be developing their ???
