## Could you be the next protector of the rainforest?

English	In literacy lessons, we will be looking at the following genres:
	Poetry – a narrative poem about a journey through the rainforest.
	Diaries – this will be from the point of view of an explorer of the rainforest.
	Newspaper report – this will be describing the discovery of a new tribe.
	Stories from other cultures- the children will be looking at stories from South America and writing their own.
	Non-chronological report – this will focus on Deforestation and its effect on the environment.
Maths	After the children have had their SATs test, they will use approximate equivalences between metric units and common imperial units such as inches, pounds and pints. Then they will measure and calculate the perimeter and area of composite rectilinear shapes in centimetres and metres. Also, they will have the opportunity to solve comparison, sum and difference problems using information presented in a line graph.
Geography	In geography the children will be looking at rainforests across the world, they will look at the human and physical geography and describe the key aspects of them. They will also look at deforestation and the effect it has had on the environment.
Science	Year 6 will look at living things and their habitats, concentrating in particular on animals from the rainforest. They will then describe the differences in the life cycles of a mammal, an amphibian, an insect and a bird.
Computing	Children will be researching rainforests around the world, this will include use search technologies effectively, appreciate how results are selected and ranked, and be discerning in evaluating digital content.
PE	This term, children will take part in outdoor and adventurous activity challenges both individually and within a team in sports such as rounders and athletics.
Art/D&T	The children will design and make the diorama using natural materials and sculpting. After that, they will research Henri Rousseau and design a back drop for the diorama.
