English	<p>In literacy lessons, we will be looking at the following genres:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Film review – reviewing the Day of the Dead film – Coco• Biography – of Donald Trump’s life• Informal Letter – taking on the role of Stanley Yelnats from Holes• Persuasive Writing – linked to Camp Green Lake from Holes• Newspaper Report – linked to corruption, criminals and victims
Numeracy	<p>The children will be working on basic number work in mathematics lessons. They will look at: place value, addition/subtraction, multiplication/division and fractions, decimals and percentages.</p>
Science	<p>In year 6, the children will be looking at electricity first and making their own electrical circuits. The children will then focus on light and how light travels. Within this topic, we will also focus on the eye and the connection between the eye and light.</p>
Geography	<p>In geography lessons, the children will first begin to look at deserts and the physical features of deserts around the world. We will then move onto looking at Mexico and the USA and comparing and contrasting the two different places.</p>
Computing	<p>Children will be researching deserts around the world, this will include using search technologies effectively, appreciating how results are selected and ranked, and being discerning in evaluating digital content.</p>
Art	<p>In art, the children will be looking at the Day of the Dead and will focus on the artist - Jose Posada (a Mexican folk artist). The children will then plan, design, make and evaluate their own Day of the Dead masks.</p>
PE	<p>In PE, the children will be working with rugby coaches from Hull FC. They will be working on their passing and throwing techniques and their understanding of rugby.</p>
D&T	<p>In DT, the children will be researching a range of different traditional Mexican food. They will research different diets and how Mexican food caters for this. Children will then make their own recipes and evaluate their Mexican dish.</p>
