Attendance Easter Egg Hunt

Dear Families,

Following on from the success of our 16 Days of Christmas attendance challenge, I am really pleased to announce our Attendance Easter Egg Hunt. March is a short month in school and only consists of 16 school days, so this initiative will run throughout the month of March. It involves individual and class challenges:

- Individual challenge: Each child will be given a Easter Egg Hunt sheet and they will be able to colour an egg every day that they are in school. If on the 22nd March, they have coloured every egg (i.e. they have full attendance for March), they will be able to exchange their tree for an Easter Egg.
- Class challenge: Every day that a class has full attendance, the children will be able to get a treat from the class tub and representatives from the classes will be able to colour in the giant egg in the hall.

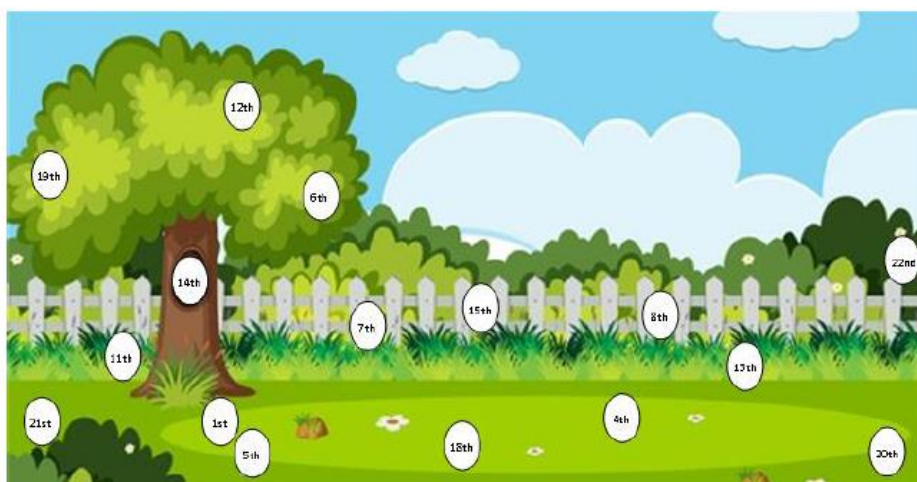
