I am delighted to let you know that we are now in the position of booking places for the clubs that will run next half term. These clubs are in addition to our daily after school club. The following clubs will run for 4/5 weeks starting next week (week commencing 21st April) and will begin at the end of the school day until 4:15:

Places are limited and will be allocated on a first come first served basis, booking using the school money payment system. If the club shows as unavailable online, it is likely to be full, please contact the school office to join the waiting list. A nominal payment of £1 for the half term for each club, allows us to use the online booking system. Please note the additional cost for the Miniature Model club to cover materials and staffing. All clubs are subsidised by the school and places in clubs are subject to regular attendance and adherence to the school behaviour expectations.

I would also like to remind you all of the changes to the Breakfast club after half term. All children can attend from 8:15 for a free breakfast and if you require childcare from 7:45, there will be a charge of £1 per child per day. All places need to be booked on the School Money App or website (Click link: [School Payments | Online School Payment System | SchoolMoney by Eduspot](#)). Children arriving for the 7:45 childcare will need to enter through the school office to be registered, children arriving for 8:15 should wait at the school gate and will enter through the hall doors. Please note that for the later session, you will not be able to wait on the school grounds as there is no supervision at that time. Initially you will only be able to book for the first 2 weeks as we adjust to the new system.
